

Chapter 12 – Section 12.06

ELECTION COMMITTEE

POLICY: The Rotonda West Association (RWA) is authorized by Florida Statutes 720 and 617 to organize according to the needs of the Association. The RWA By-Laws, in Article II, Section 10, allow the Board to establish committees in order to facilitate the over-all operations of the association. The Election Committee is hereby authorized as a Non-required Standing Operating Committee according to the Rotonda West Association's Policy for Committees, Section 12.0, to carry out the purposes stated in the Charter below. The Committee is also authorized to make recommendations to the Board of Directors as may reasonably be necessary to advance the interests of the RWA. The Board has the option of modifying the Charter at any time.

CHARTER: Two people are elected to the board of directors at each annual meeting in December. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes will serve three-year terms. The Election Committee establishes the rules, procedures and political campaign guidelines for holding annual elections. *These guidelines are contained in the version of the document, "**Election Committee Rules, Procedures and Political Campaign Guidelines**", most recently recorded with the Charlotte County Clerk of Circuit Court.*
