## Administration

- Collected and processed approximately 97% of Member's Assessment payments
- Processed and mailed out approximately 60 new homeowner packets, so far, for the month of November so far
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances

- Currently, there are **1,522** Constant Contact Members signed up receiving important updates and Meeting information
- Processed 2 Proof of Claim for Payment of Surplus Funds from Tax Deed Sale in the Pine Valley and Long Meadow section
- Processed approximately 44 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Collected and processed approximately **50** estoppels so far this month

## **Rotonda West Maintenance Staff**

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Mowed and treated the weeds around the **5** front entrance signs
  - Repaired photocell sensors at the Pebble Beach, Pinehurst, and Long Meadow Memorial Parks
  - Repaired photocell sensors at the Blvd West, Blvd North, and the Blvd East front entrance signs
  - Added additional outlets to the Gazebo island and Memorial Park in the Oakland Hills section
  - Replaced broken landscape lights at the Long Meadow and White Marsh Memorial Parks
  - Mowed vacant lots in the Pinehurst sections
  - Mowing vacant lots in the Broadmoor section
  - Trimming the arecas around the Community Center and Administration office
  - Cleaned up and blew off debris from the 3 1/2 miles of multi-use walking trails inside Broadmoor Park
  - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the Administration and Community Center buildings
  - Installed new native plants and mulch around Lake Farrell at Broadmoor Park
  - Will continue mowing vacant lots in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow section next week
  - Completed trash pick-up and emptying of 16 dog waste stations around Parade Circle and Broadmoor Park
- Will continue completing weekly trash cleanups throughout all sections of Rotonda West
