Administration

- Collected and processed approximately 97% of Member's Assessment payments
- Updating the New Construction Clean Site deposits with approximately 185 homes that are still awaiting final Certificate of Occupancy
- The Compliance Officers have been active updating and recording invasive tree vacant lot violations
- Received and reviewed 3 printing quotes for our yearly Annual Assessment notice mailout

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds along the apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections
 - Replaced all of the American Flags at the Memorial Parks
 - Mowed and trimmed 1 residential property under violation for high grass in the Oakland Hills section that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined)
 - Trimming and mulching the landscaped beds around all of the **5** front entrance signs entering Rotonda West (waiting on mulch deliveries)
 - Removed 4 dead pine trees that were infested with pine bores around
 L08 inside Broadmoor Park
 - Mowed vacant lots in the Pine Valley and Oakland Hills sections
 - Mowing vacant lots in the Oakland Hills section of Boundary Blvd
 - Removed fatigued shrubs from the native garden around Lake Farrell at Broadmoor Park and prepped for new plants to be installed in the coming weeks
 - Will continue treating the weeds and adding mulch around the sectional signs of Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd
 - Will begin mowing vacant lots in the Pebble Beach section next week
 - Completed trash pick-up and emptying of 16 dog waste stations around Parade Circle and Broadmoor Park
- Will continue completing weekly trash cleanups throughout all sections of Rotonda West
 - Work Locations of Maintenance are available for viewing in the Rotonda West Association Office

- Cross Creek Environmental completed a follow-up appointment this week
 (11/1) treating the aquatic and terrestrial plantings around the L04 pond
- Bob Reynolds has completed his **4th** canal bank mowing cycle of the year and will begin the **5th** cycle in approximately 1 week
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- The following canals and areas have been sprayed for invasives and grasses
 - Pinehurst
 - Broadmoor
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Broadmoor
 - White Marsh
- FloridAquatics will be treating grasses in the White Marsh sections next week
- FloridAquatics will be removing Vallisneria and invasives in the White Marsh sections next week
