Administration

- The Annual Assessments were mailed out 12-16 and 12-17 and members should have received or should be receiving their Assessments. If you have not received your annual assessment, please email us at info@rotondawest.org
- Processed and posted approximately 54% of Annual Assessment payments to member's accounts
- Released a lien on 1 property in the Pine Valley section
- Recorded **2** liens on properties that have outstanding Deed Violations or unpaid Assessments in the Oakland Hills and Long Meadow section
- Processed 1 Proof of Claim for Payment of Surplus Funds from Tax Deed Sale in the Long Meadow section

- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard processing and approving **72** applications, so far this month
- December 20th thru January 11th contacted property owners by e-mail, phone, or letters for the approximate 380 Deed Restriction violations. In total 46 of the violations had no Residential Modification Approval

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Added native grasses and plants around the front entrance sign at Rebel Ct
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds along the humpback bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Pinehurst, and Broadmoor sections
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds at the Gazebo Island Park
 - Treated areas around Broadmoor Park for invasive species
 - Treated the weeds on the multi-use paths at all of the Memorial Parks and the Oakland Hills boat ramp marina
 - Completed adding mulch around the front entrance signs of Rotonda West Blvd and Rebel Ct
 - Removed 3 trailer loads of illegally dumped debris from vacant lots in the Pinehurst and Broadmoor sections
 - Will be mowing vacant lots in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow section next week
 - Mowing vacant lots in the Broadmoor section
 - Mowed vacant lots in the Pinehurst section of Boundary Blvd from Rebel Ct thru North Blvd
 - Mowed around the Community Center, common areas, and swales inside Broadmoor Park
 - Continuing to power wash around the Community Center and Administration Buildings
 - Continuing to water the new plants around Broadmoor Park along with Rotonda West Blvd and Rebel Ct signs
 - Emptying **16** dog waste stations around Parade Circle and Broadmoor Park **twice** a week
- Will continue completing weekly trash cleanups throughout all sections of Rotonda West
 - Work Locations of Maintenance are available for viewing in the Rotonda West Association Office

Please remember to keep your furry friends leashed and to properly discard any waste in our many trash receptacles when utilizing the Rotonda West Association Parks

Contractors

- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- The following canals and areas have been sprayed for invasives and grasses
 - Pinehurst (removed dead trees in the canal)
 - Broadmoor (water lettuce)
 - Pine Valley (weir trash cleanup)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Broadmoor (water lettuce)
 - White Marsh (Vallisneria)
- FloridAquatics will be treating grasses in the Pine Valley sections next week
- FloridAquatics will be removing Vallisneria and invasives in the White Marsh sections next week
 - Work locations are available for viewing in the Rotonda West Association
