Administration

- The Annual Assessments were mailed out 12-16 and 12-17 and members should have received or should be receiving their Assessments. If you have not received your annual assessment, please email us at info@rotondawest.org
- Processed and posted approximately 80% of Annual Assessment payments to member's accounts
- Released a lien on 1 property in the Pine Valley section
- Copies of Jack Alexander's <u>Rotonda The Vision and the Reality</u> books are for sale inside the Administration Building for \$10.00 a book
- Collected and processed approximately **35** estoppels so far this month
- Currently there are 1,580 Constant Contact Members signed up receiving important updates and Meeting information
- Updating the New Construction Clean Site deposits with approximately 193 homes that are still awaiting final Certificate of Occupancy
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Removed large invasives along the **L06** lake areas at Broadmoor Park
 - Treated the weeds around all the apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and Long Meadow sections
 - Added an additional 20 cubic yards of dirt along L06 lake at Broadmoor Park helping control the erosion along the shoreline
 - Cleaned up and blew off debris from the 3 1/2 miles of multi-use walking trails inside Broadmoor Park
 - Installed 2 new toilets in the Administration Building
 - Continuing to organize and clean the storage facilities in Maintenance Building A and B
 - Mowing vacant lots in the Pine Valley section
 - Continuing to trim and treat the palm trees, palmettos, pine trees, and oak trees around the Community Center and common areas
 - Completed trimming around manhole covers and drains in the 21 miles of greenbelts and other common areas
 - Completed adding native grasses and plants around the L04 lake at Broadmoor Park
 - Continuing to water the new plants around Broadmoor Park along with Rotonda West Blvd, Rebel Ct signs, and North Blvd
 - Emptying 16 dog waste stations around Parade Circle and Broadmoor Park twice a week
- Will continue completing weekly trash cleanups throughout all sections of Rotonda West

Contractors

- Josh Brown Landscape has started Phase III of the Brazilian Pepper tree
 mulching program inside Broadmoor Park and should be completed mulching in
 approximately two weeks
- Cross Creek Environmental completed aquatic and terrestrial plantings around the **L04** pond and will follow up with treatment in approximately 3 weeks
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- The following canals and areas have been sprayed for invasives and grasses
 - White Marsh
 - Pine Valley
- FloridAquatics will be treating grasses in the White Marsh sections next week
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Pine Valley Weir
- FloridAquatics will be removing Vallisneria and invasives in the White Marsh sections next week
 - Work locations are available for viewing in the Rotonda West Association Office
