Administration

 Processed and posted approximately 85% of Annual Assessment payments to member's accounts

- Collected and processed approximately 45 estoppels so far this month
- Released a lien on 1 property in the Pine Valley section
- Copies of Jack Alexander's <u>Rotonda The Vision and the Reality</u> books are for sale inside the Administration Building for \$10.00 a book
- Processed approximately **55** parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Processed and mailed out approximately 50 new homeowner packets so far this month
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard processing and approving 210 applications this month. Please make sure to complete your entire application so we can process it efficiently and it will be approved

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around all of the Memorial Parks
 - Removed fatigued shrubs from around the Administration parking lot landscaped curbed islands and began installing new native plants and mulch
 - Removed 1 pickup truck full of rebar that was dumped on an empty lot in the White Marsh section
 - Repaired the GFCI outlet and spotlight at the Pinehurst Memorial Park
 - Mowing around the common areas and swales inside Broadmoor Park
 - Treated the weeds around the multi-use paths at Broadmoor Park
 - Continuing to remove and treat all invasives around all of the lakes and common areas inside Broadmoor Park.
 - Continuing to water the new plants around Broadmoor Park along with Rotonda West Blvd, Rebel Ct signs, North Blvd, and East Blvd
 - Emptying 16 dog waste stations around Parade Circle and Broadmoor Park twice a week
- Will continue completing weekly trash cleanups throughout all sections of Rotonda West
 - Work Locations of Maintenance are available for viewing in the Rotonda West Association Office

Please remember to keep your furry friends leashed and to properly discard any waste in our many trash receptacles when utilizing the Rotonda West Association Parks

- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
