## Administration

- Processed and posted approximately 90% of Annual Assessment payments to member's accounts
- Collected and processed approximately 50 estoppels so far this month
- Released a lien on 1 property in the Oakland Hills section

- Processed and mailed out approximately **52** new homeowner packets so far this month
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting **27** past due payments this week

## **Rotonda West Maintenance Staff**

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Removed **1** pickup truck and trailer full of couches and miscellaneous debris that was dumped on empty properties in the Broadmoor and Oakland Hills section
  - Mowed, trimmed, and sprayed vacant properties in the Oakland Hills and Broadmoor section that are being neglected (*they are being charged for our services and fined*)
  - Prepped and Planted 2 large oak trees around L04 walking trail at Broadmoor Park
  - Finished mowing the vacant lots in the Oakland Hills section
  - Mowed vacant lots in the Oakland Hills and Pebble Beach section of Boundary Blvd and Rotonda Circle from Cape Haze Drive thru Rebel Blvd
  - Continuing to remove and treat all **invasives** around all of the lakes and common areas inside Broadmoor Park. This is an extensive job with the staff already removing **100** invasive species of trees to date
- Will continue mowing vacant lots in the Pebble Beach section next week
- Will continue completing **weekly trash cleanups** throughout all sections of Rotonda West
