Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds along all of the Humpback Bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Pinehurst, Broadmoor, Long Meadow, White Marsh, and Pine Valley sections on Rotonda Circle
 - Cleaned up limbs and branches along the **3 1/2** miles of walking paths inside Broadmoor Park
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds along the common areas off Parade Circle and the side streets from Cape Haze Drive through White Marsh Road
 - Added 5 cubic yards of washed shell to the walking paths inside Broadmoor Park
 - Mowed, trimmed, and sprayed vacant properties in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, and Broadmoor section that are being neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined)

- Finished mowing the vacant lots in the **Broadmoor** section and started mowing vacant lots in the **Long Meadow** section
- Finished mowing greenbelts in all of the sections that span approximately 21 miles that we were able to mow(weather permitting) and will begin mowing the hard to reach areas of the greenbelts in the coming weeks with the FloridAquatics Truxor
- Will begin mowing and treating weeds at all of the construction sites that
 have not complied with Section 5 of our Deed Restrictions (they are
 being charged for our services and fined)

- Bob Reynolds has completed the 2nd canal bank mowing cycle this
 week and will begin the 3rd cycle in approximately three weeks
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- The following canals and areas have been sprayed for invasives and grasses
 - Pebble Beach finger lakes(grasses)
 - Broadmoor finger lakes(grasses)
 - Broadmoor Park(grasses)
 - White Marsh finger lakes(grasses)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Broadmoor(apex bridge)
