 - Mowed, trimmed, edged, and treated the weeds around the Memorial Parks
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the common areas off Parade Circle and the side streets from Cape Haze Drive through White Marsh Road
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the Community Center and Administration Building
 - Mowing the intersections along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd from Cape Haze Drive to East Blvd

- Will continue mowing and treating weeds at all of the construction sites that have not complied with **Section 5** of our Deed Restrictions <u>(they are being charged for our services and fined)</u>
