## **Rotonda West Maintenance Staff**

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Finished Mowing vacant lots in the **White Marsh** and **Pine Valley** sections and started mowing vacant lots in the **Oakland Hills** section
  - Mowing and treating the weeds at all of the construction sites that have not complied with Section 5 of our Deed Restrictions (they are being charged for our services and fined)
  - Finished mowing, trimming, and treating the weeds around the common areas off Parade Circle and the side streets from Cape Haze Drive through White Marsh Road
  - Mowed and trimmed 2 residential properties under violation for high grass in the Pebble Beach and Pinehurst section that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined)
  - Mowed around the meadows, swales, and other common areas inside Broadmoor Park
  - Mowed and treated invasive species around Lake Farrell and L09 inside Broadmoor Park
  - Began mowing and trimming around the Humpback Bridges on Rotonda Circle in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Pinehurst, Broadmoor, and Long Meadow sections
