- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Finished Mowing vacant lots in the **Oakland Hills** section and started mowing vacant lots in the **Pebble Beach** section
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds at all of the Memorial Parks
 - Trimmed the landscape shrubs around the Community Center and Administration Building, pulling the weeds and applying mulch as needed
 - Mowed and trimmed 4 residential properties under violation for high grass in the Pebble Beach and Pinehurst section that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined)
 - Mowed around the Administration Building and Community Center inside Broadmoor Park
 - Added another treatment to the invasive species around Lake Farrell and L09 inside Broadmoor Park
 - Mowed and trimmed around the Humpback Bridges on Rotonda Circle from Oakland Hills thru the Pine Valley section
