 - Mowed and treated the weeds around the intersections along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd of Cape Haze Drive, West Blvd, Rebel Ct, North Blvd, and East Blvd
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the common areas off **Parade Circle** and the side streets from Cape Haze Drive through White Marsh Road
 - Removed 2 Brazilian Pepper trees on a residential property in the Broadmoor section under Section
