- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris
 - Added 8 new 100-watt lights to the Oakland Hills Marina parking lot
 - Hauled 14 cubic yards of scrap debris to the junkyard
 - Brokedown and set up tables and chairs for 1 Board Meeting and
 12 club and activity meetings in the Community Center
 - Installed 10 more drop-down ceiling lights in the Community Center
 - Installed metal shelving inside Maintenace Building #2 Bay 1 to help reorganize and add additional storage for clubs and activities
 - Installed 6 cameras damaged by Hurricane Ian around the Community Center that were under warranty
 - Work Locations of Maintenance are available in the Rotonda West Association Office.
