## **Rotonda West Maintenance Staff**

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris
  - Broke-down and set up tables and chairs for 2 Committee Meetings, 16 club and activity meetings
  - Hauled away 20 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris in the Oakland Hills Greenbelts
  - Mowed Greenbelts in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Pinehurst, Broadmoor, Long Meadow, White Marsh, and the Pine Valley sections
  - Mowing, trimming, and treating the weeds along all of the Humpback Bridges along Rotonda Circle
  - Installed 6 more drop-down ceiling lights in the Community Center, having installed approximately 64

- Began work in the Oakland Hills greenbelt, clearing 2
  large ficus trees and 1 large oak tree, and will continue
  cleaning up fallen debris in the Oakland Hills greenbelts
  next week
- Will begin mowing vacant lots in the Oakland Hills section in approximately 3 weeks
