- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris
 - Broke down and set up tables and chairs for 1 Board Meeting, 2 Committee Meetings, 13 club and activity meetings
 - Mowed and trimmed 1 residential property under Section 16. In the Pinehurst section that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and

- Hauled away 15 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and our common areas in the Oakland Hills section
- Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds along all of the Apex Bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections
- Added plants and mulch to the front entrance signs at North Blvd and East Blvd and will begin adding more plants and mulch to the other 3 front entrance signs in the coming weeks
- Mowed vacant lots in the Oakland Hills section and will continue mowing in the Pebble Beach section next week
- Following up behind the mowers picking up miscellaneous debris and trash in the vacant lots, Greenbelts, and other common areas that have been mowed
