



Administration

- Collected and processed 25 estoppels so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 21 new homeowner packets this month
- Processed 19 sign approvals this month
- Released 1 Claim of Lien on a property in the Long Meadow section
- Received approximately 6280 assessment payments. Due to Hurricane Ian, The Rotonda West Association Assessments were due on February 1, 2023. Please get in touch with Sheryl@rotondawest.org to make other arrangements if payment assistance is needed or help is needed making a payment
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 29 signs this week

## **Rotonda West Maintenance Staff**

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris
  - Hauled away 40 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and our common areas in the Oakland Hills, Pinehurst, and Broadmoor section
  - Added plants and mulch to the front entrance signs at North Blvd., East Blvd., and Cape Haze Drive and began adding plants to the Blvd West front entrance sign
  - Will be clearing debris from the greenbelts in the Long Meadow section in the coming weeks.
  - Started making repairs to the docks at the Oakland Hills Marina and will continue early next week
  - Started making repairs to the fences around the Administration and Maintenance buildings around Broadmoor Park and will continue early next week
  - Mowed vacant lots in the Pinehurst section and will begin cutting the Broadmoor section next week

- Following up behind the mowers picking up miscellaneous debris and trash in the vacant lots, Greenbelts, and other common areas that have been mowed

- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system

- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections.
