- Collected and processed 33 estoppels in February
- Processed and mailed out 31 new homeowner packets in February
- Processed 23 sign approvals in February
- Processed 1 Proof of Claim for Payment of Surplus Funds from Tax Deed Sale in the Pine Valley section
- Released 1 Claim of Lien on a property in the White Marsh section

- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 4 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$2173
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 442 signs this week

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris
 - Repaired irrigation Zone Valves and Solenoids around the Community Center

- Hauled away 45 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and our common areas in the Oakland Hills, Broadmoor, and Long Meadow sections
- Added plants and mulch to the front entrance signs at North Blvd., East Blvd., Cape Haze Drive, and Blvd West and began cleaning and adding plants around the Rebel Ct front entrance sign
- We will be clearing debris from the greenbelts in the Long Meadow section in the coming weeks.
- Completed repairs to the fences around the Administration and Maintenance buildings around Broadmoor Park
- Mowed vacant lots in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow sections and started cutting the White Marsh section this week
- Following up behind the mowers picking up miscellaneous debris and trash in the vacant lots, Greenbelts, and other common areas that have been mowed
