



Administration

- Collected and processed 23 estoppels so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 26 new homeowner packets so far this month
- Processed 90 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Sent out 154 past-due assessment notices to members that have not paid this year's assessments
- We received approximately 7483 assessment payments. Due to Hurricane Ian, The Rotonda West Association Assessments were due on February 1, 2023. Please get in touch with <u>Sheryl@rotondawest.org</u> to make other arrangements if payment assistance is needed or help is needed making a payment

- Currently, there are 4,150 Constant Contact Members signed up to receive important updates and Meeting information
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 193 applications this month. <u>Please make</u> <u>sure to complete your entire Residential Modification</u> <u>application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be</u> <u>approved.</u>
- Contacted property owners by e-mail, phone, or letters for the approximate 1099 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings. In total, 70 violations turned into fines for members not adhering to the warnings
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 9 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$3860
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 45 signs this week

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris around L08 and L09 https://rotondawest.org/?s=Broadmoor+Park+Map
 - Hauled away 20 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and the common areas in the Oakland Hills and Pebble Beach sections
 - Replaced all of the American Flags at the Memorial Parks
 - Adding mulch and treating the weeds around the segment signs on Rotonda Circle
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the common areas off Parade Circle and the side streets from Cape Haze Drive through White Marsh Road
 - Mowed around the intersections along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd of Cape Haze Drive, West Blvd, Rebel Ct, North Blvd, and East Blvd
 - Mowed the common areas inside Broadmoor Park
 - Added native grasses and plants around the bridges on Cape Haze Drive and Rebel Ct bridge
 - Removed 175 cubic yards of fallen debris and dead trees along the Boundary Blvd Greenbelts in the Broadmoor section

- Following up behind the mowers picking up miscellaneous debris and trash in the vacant lots, Greenbelts, and other common areas that have been mowed

- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system

 - Pinehurst

 - White Marsh
