- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:

 - Hauled away **15** cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and the common areas in the **Pinehurst** section
 - Adding mulch and treating the weeds around the segment signs on Rotonda Circle and will be adding mulch to the segment signs along Boundary Blvd in the next couple of weeks
 - Broke down and set up tables and chairs for 1 closed Board Meeting, 3 Committee Meetings, 16 club and activity meetings

 - Removed **135** cubic yards of fallen debris and dead trees along the **Greenbelts** in the **Pebble Beach and Oakland Hills** sections.
