Administration

- Collected and processed 13 estoppels this month
- This month, we have processed 17 estoppel requests that provide insight into upcoming property transfers. If you would like to learn more about Estoppel Certificates, please get in touch with derrick@rotondawest.org
- Processed and mailed out 10 new homeowner packets this month
- Processed 40 parking passes and additional permits this month
- This month, worked with 3 RWA members to help them secure contracts for the removal of Brazilian Pepper trees or dead trees on unimproved vacant lots
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 87 applications so far this month. <u>Please</u> <u>make sure to complete your entire Residential Modification</u> <u>application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be approved.</u>
- This week we received and handled 1 deposit for a new construction site, bringing the total number of homes under construction to 299
- Released 1 Claim of Liens on a property located in the White Marsh section
- Assisted members in setting up payment plans and successfully added 1 additional member this week
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 8 signs this week
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 4 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$2579

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris around L01, L02, L05, L06, L08 and L10 https://rotondawest.org/?s=Broadmoor+Park+Map
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the **5** front entrance signs
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the Administration and Community Center buildings

- Currently working on removing and treating invasive plants in areas surrounding L07 within Broadmoor Park
- Mowed and trimmed 2 residential properties under Section 16. in the Oakland Hills sections that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowed vacant lots in the White Marsh section and started mowing vacant lots in the Pine Valley section
- Will continue mowing within Broadmoor Park next week.

Contractors

- Debris from Hurricane Ian are now being cleared from Broadmoor Park by FDEM.
- Bob Reynolds has begun his 3rd cycle of mowing the canal banks in the Broadmoor, Long Meadow, and White Marsh sections
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- The following canals and areas have been sprayed for invasives and grasses
 - Oakland Hills (algae)
 - Pebble Beach(finger lakes)
 - White Marsh(finger lakes)
 - Broadmoor Park
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - White Marsh
