Administration

- Collected and processed 27 estoppels this month
- This month, we have processed 39 estoppel requests that provide insight into upcoming property transfers. If you would like to learn more about Estoppel Certificates, please get in touch with <u>derrick@rotondawest.org</u>
- Processed and mailed out 25 new homeowner packets this month
- Processed 79 parking passes and additional permits this month
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of Brazilian Pepper trees on their unimproved vacant lot
- Released 1 Claim of Lien on a property located in the Pinehurst section
- Successfully processed 2 Proofs of Claims for Payment of Surplus Funds resulting from a Tax Deed and Foreclosure sale in the Long Meadow and Pinehurst section
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 162 applications this month. <u>Please make</u> <u>sure to complete your entire Residential Modification</u> <u>application so that we can process it efficiently and it will be</u> <u>approved.</u>
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **9** signs this week
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting **2** past-due payments this week, collecting approximately **\$3430**
- Rotonda West Maintenance Staff
- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris around L08, L11, and L12 <u>https://rotondawest.org/?s=Broadmoor+Park+Map</u>
  - Currently working on removing and treating invasive plants in areas surrounding **L08 and L11** within Broadmoor Park
  - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the Community Center and Administration buildings
  - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around all of the Memorial Parks
  - Mowed around the intersections along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd of Cape Haze Drive, West Blvd, Rebel Ct, North Blvd, and East Blvd

- Mowed and trimmed 1 residential property under Section 16. in the Oakland Hills sections that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowed vacant lots in the **Oakland Hills** section and will start mowing vacant lots in the **Pebble Beach** section
- Hauled away 20 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and the common areas in the Oakland Hills, Broadmoor, Long Meadow, and Pine Valley sections
- Will continue mowing within Broadmoor Park next week

## • Contractors

- The **FDEM** has cleared approximately **17,000** cubic yards of debris from Broadmoor Park left by Hurricane Ian.
- Diversified Services is assisting the RWA maintenance team in clearing debris from common areas within Broadmoor Park.
- Bob Reynolds has completed his **3rd** round of mowing the canal banks and will start his **4th** round in the upcoming weeks.
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
  - Long Meadow
  - Pinevalley
