Administration

- Collected and processed 10 estoppels this month
- Processed and mailed out 14 new homeowner packets this month
- Processed 23 parking passes and additional permits this month
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of lot clearing of trees on their unimproved vacant lot
- Successfully processed and updated 20 address changes for existing members of the RWA
- Assisted members in setting up payment plans and successfully added 1 additional member this week
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 27 signs this week
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 2 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$1663

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to work in Broadmoor Park, removing and hauling away fallen pine trees and other debris around L11 https://rotondawest.org/?s=Broadmoor+Park+Map
 - Painting the walls and doors in the card room at the Community Center
 - Hauled away 34 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and the common areas in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow sections
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around all of the Memorial Parks
 - Completed mowing, trimming, and treating the weeds along the Apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections
 - Mowed and trimmed 6 residential properties under Section 16. in the Oakland Hills and Pebble Beach sections that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and

- The FDEM has cleared approximately 21,700 cubic yards of debris from Broadmoor Park left by Hurricane Ian
- Diversified Services is assisting the RWA maintenance team in clearing debris from common areas within Broadmoor Park
- Bob Reynolds has completed his 3rd round of mowing the canal banks and will start his 4th round in the upcoming weeks
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Pebble Beach(grasses)
 - Pinehurst(grasses)
 - Pinehurst(algae treatment)
 - Broadmoor(grasses)
