Administration

Received and handled 6 New Construction Clean Site deposits

- Collected and processed **16** estoppels so far this month
- Processed 90 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 29 new homeowner packets so far this month
- Reached out to property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters regarding around 699 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings.
 Out of these, 62 violations resulted in first-time fines for members who did not follow the warnings
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and are proud to have helped 26 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of Brazilian Pepper trees on their unimproved vacant lot
- Assisted in updating the accounts of 9 members, ensuring that they
 receive communication from the Rotonda West Association
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **11** signs this week
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 2 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$1450

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Removed dead trees along the walking paths around L04, and L03 inside Broadmoor Park

 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the unwanted weeds around the Memorial Parks
 - Mowing, trimming, and treating the unwanted weeds around Parade Circle from Cape Haze Drive through White Marsh Road
 - Mowing the swales and other common areas inside Broadmoor Park weather permitting
 - Spot-treated the weeds that were present along the 3.5 miles of walking paths at Broadmoor Park

- Assembly and disassembly of tables and chairs for a total of 20 meetings, including 1 Board Meeting and 19 club and activity meetings
- Removed port-a-potties, dead trees, and 8 yards of miscellaneous debris from unimproved vacant lots in the White Marsh section
- Mowed and trimmed 4 residential properties under Section 16. in the Oakland Hills and Pinehurst sections that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowing vacant lots in the Oakland Hills section and will begin mowing in the Pebble Beach section next week
- Starting next week, we will begin cleaning up new construction sites that have not complied with our violation notices

Contractors

- Bob Reynolds has completed his **4th** cycle of mowing the canal banks and will begin his **5th** cycle in approximately 3 weeks
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Oakland Hills(spot treat grasses)
 - Pebble Beach(spot treat grasses)
 - Broadmoor(finger lakes)
 - Broadmoor Park(grasses)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Long Meadow(apex bridges)
 - White Marsh
 - Pine Valley
