



Administration

- Received and handled 6 New Construction Clean Site deposits
- Collected and processed **7** estoppels so far this month
- Processed 47 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 7 new homeowner packets so far this month
- Reached out to property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters regarding around 904 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings.

- Out of these, **136** violations resulted in first-time fines for members who did not correct the warnings
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and are proud to have helped 13 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of Brazilian Pepper trees on their unimproved vacant lot
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 22 signs this week
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 2 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$1100

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Adding landscaping around the Butterfly Garden and installing planters near the Community Center
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around all of the Memorial Parks
 - As the area dries up, we have been continuing to mow the communal areas and swales within Broadmoor Park
 - Mowed around the Apex bridges on Rotonda Circle, Boundary Blvd, and the Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections.
 - Removed fencing and miscellaneous debris from unimproved vacant lots in the Pine Valley section totaling 15 yards
 - Removed Brazilian Pepper and dead trees from 1 unimproved vacant property under Section 16. in the Pine Valley section that was neglected (they are being charged for our services) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
 - Painting the walls and doors in the kitchen area at the Community Center
 - Mowed and trimmed 2 New Construction sites under Section 5. in the Pinehurst and Broadmoor sections that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and
