



Administration

- Collected and processed 14 estoppels so far this month
- Processed 2 deposits, resulting in 264 new construction sites that are currently in progress
- Processed 82 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 11 new homeowner packets so far this month
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 162 applications so far this month. <u>Please</u> <u>make sure to complete your entire Residential Modification</u>

application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be approved.

- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and are proud to have helped 15 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- This week, worked with 4 RWA members to help them secure a contract for the removal of Brazilian Pepper trees on their unimproved vacant lot
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 52 signs this week
- Continuing collection efforts by calling members with past-due account balances, collecting 3 past-due payments this week, collecting approximately \$4150

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Currently working on removing and treating the weeds around the 5 front entrance signs
 - Treated the weeds around the segment signs located on Rotonda Circle and Boundary Boulevard
 - 10 yards of miscellaneous debris and 2 porta-potties were removed from unimproved vacant lots in Pebble Beach and Pinehurst sections
 - The walls and doors in the bathroom areas of the Community Center are being painted
 - Mowing and trimming around the common areas off Parade
 Circle and the side streets from Cape Haze Drive through White
 Marsh Road
 - We had the pleasure of working with the awesome folks at Casteel Electric to bring electricity to the entrance of beautiful Broadmoor Park! It's almost done and we can't wait for you to enjoy it in just one week!
 - Fixed and adjusted the irrigation system around the Community Center and the butterfly gardens to ensure proper water supply
 - Treated the weeds on 3.5 miles of walking paths at Broadmoor Park.
 - Mowed and trimmed 2 New Construction sites under Section 5. in the Pinehurst and Broadmoor sections that are neglected (they

- Mowed vacant lots in the Long Meadow section and will begin mowing in the White Marsh section next week
- Mowing the walking paths and common areas around Broadmoor Park and we'll be continuing the work next week
- Starting next week, we will continue cleaning up **new construction sites** that have not complied with our violation notices
