Administration

- Processed and mailed out approximately 8040 annual assessments that are due on January 1st. We have received 2045 payments so far. If you need any help making a payment or setting up a payment plan, please don't hesitate to reach out to us at Jenny@rotondawest.org. We're always here to help!
- During this month, we have received and managed deposits for 6 new construction cleaning sites. The Rotonda West Association is currently overseeing the construction of 286 homes
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 72 applications so far this month. <u>Please</u> <u>make sure to complete your entire Residential Modification</u> <u>application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be</u> <u>approved</u>
- Collected and processed 18 estoppels so far this month
- Reached out to property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters regarding around 904 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings.
 Out of these, 136 violations resulted in first-time fines for members who did not correct the warnings
- During the week, 177 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed 44 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 12 new homeowner packets so far this month
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and are proud to have helped 20 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 23 signs this week
- This week, we collected approximately \$850 from two past-due payments for violation fines by calling members with past-due account balances

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

• The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:

- Removing dead trees and unwanted stumps that are obstructing the walking paths along L02, L03, L04, L06, and L09 inside Broadmoor Park https://rotondawest.org/?s=Broadmoor+Park+map
- Trimming the palmettos and palm trees along the L03 walking path inside Broadmoor Park
- At Broadmoor Park, we are removing any unwanted weeds, trimming the plants, and adding fresh mulch around the Community Center, Administration buildings, and parking lots
- 60 yards of dirt have been added around the L06 area inside Broadmoor Park
- 120 yards of fill are being added, and the area is being graded to prepare for concrete behind the Community Center
- Prepared the area behind the Community Center for concrete by relocating the irrigation pipes, sprinklers, and a zone valve
- Mowed and trimmed 1 residential property under Section 16. in the Pinehurst section that is neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowing vacant lots in the Pine Valley and Greenbelts section and will continue mowing in the Greenbelts next week
- Mowed and trimmed 1 New Construction site under Section 5. in the White Marsh section that is neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowing the swales around Broadmoor Park, and we will be continuing the work next week
- Starting next week, we will continue cleaning up new construction sites that have not complied with our violation notices

Contractors

- Bob Reynolds completed his 5th cycle of mowing the canal banks in Pine Valley. He finished mowing around lakes L02, L06, and L09 in Broadmoor Park
- Diversified Services is adding new cart path material around the L06 walking paths located in Broadmoor Park
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Pinehurst(trash cleanup)
 - Pinehurst(spot treat grasses)
 - Broadmoor(spot treat grasses)

- Long Meadow(spot treat grasses)
- White Marsh(trash cleanup)
- White Marsh(spot treat)
