



Administration

- Processed and mailed out approximately 8040 annual assessments that were due on January 1st. We have received 5640 payments so far. If you need any help making a payment or setting up a payment plan, please don't hesitate to reach out to us at Jenny@rotondawest.org. We're always here to help!
- Since the Annual Assessment mailing was sent out, 489 name or address changes have been processed. Please update your account information to ensure that you receive important information by emailing <u>Jenny@rotondawest.org</u>
- Collected and processed 9 estoppels and 9 transfers so far this month
- During the week, 174 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Reached out to property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters regarding around 945 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings.
  Out of these, 131 violations resulted in first-time fines for members who did not correct the warnings
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 75 applications so far this month. <u>Please</u> <u>make sure to complete your entire Residential Modification</u> <u>Application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be</u> <u>approved</u>
- Processed 48 parking passes and additional permits this month
- Processed and mailed out **9** new homeowner packets this month
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and are proud to have helped 7 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of dead trees on their unimproved vacant lot in the Long Meadow section
- Released 1 Claim Lien on members with past-due violation notices in the Pebble Beach section
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 11 signs this week
- We collected approximately \$2250 this week from 2 past-due payments for violation fines and assessment liens

## Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
  - Removing dead trees, invasive species of trees, and unwanted stumps that are around the lakes along L03, L7, and L10 inside Broadmoor Park

- Currently working on painting the interior walls, doors, and trim of the Administration Building
- Added more mulch and plants around the front entrance parking lot at Broadmoor Park and the Community Center
- Continuing to mow swales and common areas inside Broadmoor Park
- Repaired 1 irrigation solenoid and also made some irrigation repairs and adjustments to the irrigation heads around the Community Center
- Hauled away 20 cubic yards of miscellaneous debris from homes in Oakland Hills and 10 cubic yards of tree debris in Long Meadow
- Mowing the vacant lots in the Pebble Beach sections and have started mowing in the Pinehurst section this week
- Trimming up the arecas and palmetto palms located behind the Administration Building and Community Center
- Following up behind the mowers, picking up miscellaneous debris and trash in the vacant lots, Greenbelts, and other common areas that have been mowed

## Contractors

- Diversified Services is continuing to add new cart path material around the L04 walking paths located in Broadmoor Park
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
  - Pinehurst(trash and debris cleanup)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
  - White Marsh(cut Vallisneria)
