Administration

 Processed and mailed out approximately 8040 annual assessments that were due on January 1st. We have received 6345 payments so far. If you need any help making a payment or setting up a

- Since the Annual Assessment mailing was sent out, 540 name or address changes have been processed. Please update your account information to ensure that you receive important information by emailing Jenny@rotondawest.org
- Collected and processed 22 estoppels and 22 transfers so far this month
- During the week, 171 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed **159** parking passes and additional permits this month
- Processed and mailed out 19 new homeowner packets this month
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and is proud to have helped 29 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Released a Claim of Lien on a property for violation fines in the Pebble Beach section
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of dead trees on their unimproved vacant lot in the Pine Valley section
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 22 signs this week
- We collected approximately \$2850 this week from 2 past-due payments for violation fines and past-due assessments

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Continuing to remove dead trees, invasive species of trees, and unwanted stumps(weather permitting) that are around the lakes along L03, L7, and L10 inside Broadmoor Park https://rotondawest.org/?s=Broadmoor+Park+map
 - Currently working on painting the interior walls, doors, and trim of the Administration Building
 - Spot-treated the weeds along all of the walking paths at the Memorial Parks
 - Completed mowing, trimming, and treating the weeds along the Apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections

- Mowed and trimmed along the common areas off Parade Circle and the side streets from White Marsh Road through Oakland Hills Road
- As you enter Rotonda West from Cape Haze Drive, we have added more plants and mulch around the front entrance sign along the bridge and Rotonda Circle
- Removed a washing machine, bicycles, dishwasher, and 5 yards of debris from vacant lots in the Pinevalley section
- Added more mulch and pulled the weeds along the front entrance sign along Rebel Court
- Organizing, cleaning, and installing maintenance equipment in Barn
 B to ensure safety
- Mowed and trimmed 1 residential property under Section 16. in the Oakland Hills section that is neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowing the vacant lots in the Broadmoor sections and will begin mowing in the Long Meadow section next week
- Begin mowing and trimming around the Humpback Bridges on Rotonda Circle next week

Contractors

- Diversified Services is continuing to add new cart path material around the Community Center located in Broadmoor Park next week(weather permitting)
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - White Marsh(finger lakes)
 - White Marsh(trash)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - White Marsh
