 Processed and mailed out approximately 8040 annual assessments that were due on January 1st. We have received 6870 payments so far. If you need any help making a payment or setting up a

- Approximately 1700 members will receive communication from the RWA regarding delinquent payments and past-due balances.
 Reminder emails will also be sent to pay annual assessments due on February 15th, 2024
- We have recently released 1 new construction deposit for 2024 and received approval for 1 new construction build, bringing the total number of our ongoing new construction builds to 267 homes.
 These homes are currently awaiting final certification of occupancy under the New Construction Clean Site Program
- Since the Annual Assessment mailing was sent out, 575 name or address changes have been processed. Please update your account information to ensure that you receive important information by emailing <u>Jenny@rotondawest.org</u>
- Collected and processed 8 estoppels and 8 transfers so far this month
- During the week, 173 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and application
- Rotonda West Association handled 46,227 emails in the last 180 days from RWA members and colleagues
- Reached out to property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters regarding around 858 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings. Out of these, 99 violations resulted in first-time fines for members who did not correct the warnings
- Processed **45** parking passes and additional permits this month
- Processed and mailed out **10** new homeowner packets this month
- So far this month, we have processed 8 estoppel and transfer requests that provide insight into upcoming property transfers. If you would like to learn more about Estoppel Certificates, please get in touch with <u>derrick@rotondawest.org</u>
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and is proud to have helped 7 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- This week, worked with 2 RWA members to help them secure a contract for the removal of dead trees on their unimproved vacant lot in the Long Meadow section
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 6 signs this week
- We collected approximately \$700 this week from 7 past-due payments for violation fines

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Spot-treated the weeds along all of the Humpack Bridges and the landscaped beds along Rotonda Circle
 - In 2023, the Rotonda West Association was very active in coordinating the use of the Community Center. They arranged the setup and takedown of tables, chairs, and walls for a total of 26 Board Meetings, 717 club and activity meetings, and 104 Committee Meetings. They also assisted members in scheduling 20 private events.
 - The Rotonda West Association Community Center is quickly filling up for the 2024 calendar year. - We are currently watering the new sod that was recently added around the Community Center
- We removed an additional **10** cubic yards of scrap metal and debris from the Maintenance Building storage areas
- We removed 20 cubic yards of dead tree debris from the Long Meadow section of our Greenbelt
- Mowing and trimming weeds around the 5 front entrance signs from Cape Haze Drive to Blvd East.
- Mowing and trimming intersections along Rotonda Circle, West Blvd, North Blvd, and East Blvd
- Mowed and trimmed along the Humpback Bridges along Rotonda
 Circle in the Pinehurst, Broadmoor and Long Meadow sections
- Continuing to trim Muhly grasses in and around Broadmoor Park parking lot, adding mulch as needed
- Added mulch to the front entrance sign on West and East Blvd and will do the same for Rebel Ct. next week
- Added landscaped plants to the front entrance sign on Cape Haze Drive
- Welded safety chains to the back of the Shulte mower deck #2
- Mowing the vacant lots in the White Marsh sections and will begin mowing in the Pine Valley section next week
- Begin adding mulch to the Memorial Parks on Rotonda Circle next week

Contractors

- Diversified Services is installing new cart path material around the Community Center. We also prepared around the new concrete addition for sod this week in Broadmoor Park
- Precision Sod installed 3200 Square feet of bahia sod around the new concrete addition at the Community Center
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Oakland Hills(finger lakes)
 - White Marsh(trash cleanup)
 - All Memorial Parks(trash cleanup)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections.
 - White Marsh
 - Pine Valley(Vallisneria)
