Administration

- Collected and processed 21 estoppels and 21 transfers so far this month
- During the week, 118 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed and mailed 3 delinquency letters to members who have not paid their assessments on time
- This week, worked with 1 RWA member to help them secure a contract for the removal of dead trees on their unimproved vacant lot in the Oakland Hills section
- The <u>Residential Modification Committee</u> has been working hard to process and approve 82 applications so far this month. <u>Please make sure to complete your entire Residential Modification application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be approved</u>
- We contacted property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters about approximately 978 instances of violating deed restrictions. As a result, 116 first-time fines were issued, and 4 second-time fines were imposed on members who failed to rectify the violations
- Processed 39 parking passes and additional permits this month
- Processed and mailed out 24 new homeowner packets this month
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and is proud to have helped 22 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 9 signs this week
- We collected approximately \$589 this week from members who had past-due payments for violation fines and assessments

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:

- Trimmed and treated the weeds around the fire hydrants and common area poles in the **Pinehurst** sections
- Added another coat of white paint to the inside rear door of the Administration building
- Treated the weeds and added mulch around the White Marsh and Long Meadow Memorial Parks
- Mowing, trimming, and treating the weeds around all of the Memorial Parks and the Gazebo Island in the Oakland Hills section
- Mowed and trimmed the areas around the Community Center, Administration Buildings, and parking lot
- The Community Center was busy this week assembling and disassembling tables and chairs to prepare for one Board Meeting, three committee meetings, and seventeen club and activity meetings
- We removed 20 cubic yards of metal, rooftop materials, and miscellaneous fencing debris from around Maintenance Building A
- Continuing to clean up around L11 in Broadmoor Park, removing dead trees and treating invasive Brazilian Pepper Trees
- Mowing the vacant lots in the Pinehurst and Broadmoor sections and will continue mowing in the Broadmoor section next week

Contractors

- Diversified Services is installing new cart path material around the Community Center. In the coming weeks, they will return to finish the parking lot around L04 inside Broadmoor Park
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - White Marsh(Treated Vallisneria)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Pine Valley
