Administration

- Collected and processed 11 estoppels and 11 transfers so far this month
- During the week, 113 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed and mailed 7 delinquency letters to members who have not paid their assessments on time
- 1 Notice of Intent to Claim of Lien was processed for properties in the Long Meadow section

- 2 properties in the Pebble Beach and Broadmoor sections received a Notice of Intent to Foreclose Liens
- Processed 29 parking passes and additional permits this month
- Processed and mailed out 20 new homeowner packets this month
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and is proud to have helped 2 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 8 signs this week
- We collected approximately \$2,814 this week from members who had past-due payments for violation fines and assessments

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Trimmed and treated the weeds around the fire hydrants and common area poles in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, and Pinehurst sections
 - Repaired and painted the rear door of the Administration building
 - Treated the weeds and removed canal debris around the apex bridges in the Broadmoor section
 - Treated the weeds and added mulch around the Pine Valley Memorial Park
 - New irrigation heads and a zone valve were added to the Community Center's patio and walking path area
 - We removed 15 cubic yards of tree debris from the Pinehurst section, a wooden dock, and other debris from the Pinehurst canal system
 - Removed dead pine trees and ground invasive Brazilian Pepper Trees behind the lovely homes around L11 in beautiful Broadmoor Park and will begin removing more around L11 in the coming weeks

- Removing any unwanted weeds, trimming the plants, and adding some fresh mulch and native flowers around the Community Center and Administration buildings
- Cleared **2** dead pine trees from the **Pinehurst** Greenbelt
- Mowed and trimmed 1 residential property under Section 16. in the Oakalnd Hills section that is neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wpcontent/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Mowing the vacant lots in the Pebble Beach and Pinehurst sections and will continue mowing in the Pinehurst section next week

Contractors

- Diversified Services is installing new cart path material around the Community Center
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Pinehurst(water lettuce)
 - Broadmoor(trash removal)
 - Broadmoor(water lettuce)
 - White Marsh(grasses)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - White Marsh
 - Pine Valley
