



Administration

- Collected and processed 30 estoppels and 30 transfers so far this month
- During the week, 115 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- 2 Claims of Liens were released from properties in the Pinehurst and Broadmoor section, which previously had past-due assessments and violation notices
- Reached out to property owners through emails, phone calls, and letters regarding around 981 Deed Restriction Violation Warnings. Out of these, 114 violations resulted in first-time fines for members who did not correct the warnings
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 101 applications so far this month. Please make sure to complete your entire Residential Modification Application so that we can process it efficiently, and it will be approved
- Processed 55 parking passes and additional permits this month
- Processed and mailed out 29 new homeowner packets this month
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing documents for our members and is proud to have helped 19 people so far this month! If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 13 signs this week
- Collected approximately \$6870 this week from members who had past-due payments for violation fines and assessments

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - Mowed and trimmed 2 residential properties under Section 16. In the Oakland Hills section that is neglected (they are being charged for our services and

- Mowed the vacant lots and common areas along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd at the intersection of West Blvd, North Blvd, and East Blvd
- Mowing, trimming, and spot-treating weeds at all Memorial Parks and Gazebo Island
- Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around the Community Center
- Trimmed some of the shrubbery around the Maintenance buildings and Community Center
- Mowed and spot-treated weeds around 5 entrance signs from Cape Haze Drive to East Boulevard
- Removed 10 cubic yards of tree debris from unimproved vacant lots in the Pebble Beach section
- Mowing the vacant lots in the White Marsh sections and will continue mowing in the White Marsh section next week

Contractors

- Diversified Services is installing new cart path material around the Community Center. In the coming weeks, they will return to finish the parking lot around L04 inside Broadmoor Park and the Memorial Parks
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Pine Valley(Treated grasses)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections
 - Pine Valley(Vallisneria)
