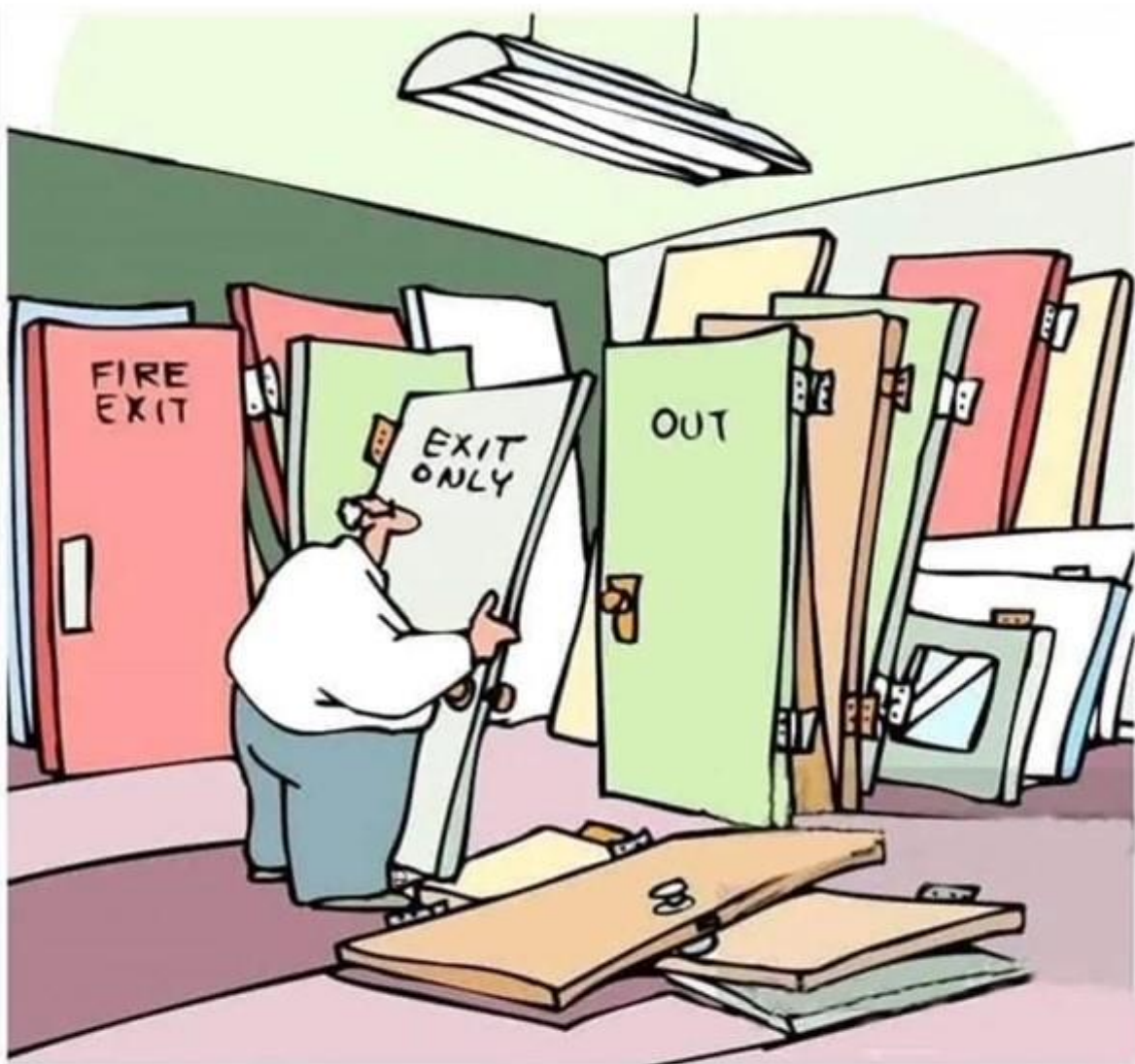




Rotonda West Association

Administration

- Collected and processed **42** estoppels and **42** transfers so far this month
- During the week, **107** members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed **84** parking passes and additional permits so far this week
- Worked with **1** RWA member to help secure a contract for the removal of dead trees and stumps on their unimproved vacant lots in the **Pebble Beach section**
- Processed **1** Claim of Lien for unpaid assessments and violation fines in the Pebble Beach section
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy **notarizing documents** for our members and is proud to have helped **47** people so far this month. If you need a document notarized, please feel free to visit the RWA office. This service is offered for **free** because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **42** signs this week
- Collected approximately **\$1000** this week from members who had past-due payments for violation fines and assessments

• Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
 - **1** neglected, unimproved vacant lot in the **Oakland Hills section** had their Brazilian Pepper Trees and dead pine trees removed (*they are being charged for our services*)
 - Spot-treated weeds along **3.5** miles of walking paths at Broadmoor Park and landscaped beds near the parking lot
 - Mowed and trimmed around the **5** entrance signs from Cape Haze Drive to East Boulevard
 - Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds at all of the **Memorial Parks and Gazebo Island**

- Reynolds Mowing has started the **2nd cycle** of mowing the canal banks in the **Broadmoor and Long Meadow section**
- Diversified Services has added walkway and driveway materials to the back and side of the Community Center
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
 - Pebble Beach (grasses and water lettuce)
 - Pinehurst (grasses)
 - Broadmoor (water lettuce)
 - Long Meadow (water lettuce)
 - Long Meadow (Apex Bridges)
 - White Marsh (grasses)
 - Pine Valley (water lettuce)
