Administration

- Collected and processed **50** estoppels and **50** transfers so far this month
- During the week, 98 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed and mailed out 38 new homeowner packets this month
- Processed 112 parking passes and additional permits so far this week
- The Residential Modification Committee has been working hard to process and approve 108 applications so far this month. <u>Please make sure to</u> <u>complete your entire Residential Modification Application so that we can</u> <u>process it efficiently, and it will be approved</u>
- This week, we worked with 8 RWA members to help them secure a contract to remove Brazilian Peppers and dead trees on their unimproved vacant lots.
 Initially, 492 unimproved vacant lots were in violation due to Brazilian Pepper Trees or dead trees. So far, we have worked with members to clear 162 of those unimproved vacant lots.
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing
 documents for our members and is proud to have helped 27 people so far this
 month. If you need a document notarized, you can visit the RWA office. This
 service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 24 signs this week
- Collected approximately \$1630 this week from members who had past-due payments for violation fines and assessments

• Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed the following tasks:
- Mowed around the 5 front entrance signs and started treating the weeds from Cape Haze Drive to East Boulevard

- Continuing to mow around the 3 1/2 miles of walking paths inside Broadmoor Park
- Spot-treated the weeds along all of the walking paths at the Memorial Parks and started trimming the landscaped areas
- Mowed the Apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections
- Mowed and trimmed along the common areas off Parade Circle and the side streets from White Marsh Road through Oakland Hills Road
- Mowed and trimmed around the intersections along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd of Cape Haze Drive, West Blvd, Rebel Ct, North Blvd, and East Blvd
- Mowed the vacant lots in the Pebble Beach and Pinehurst sections and will continue mowing in the Pinehurst section next week

Contractors

- Reynolds Mowing has finished the 2nd cycle of mowing the canal banks and will begin his 3rd cycle next week
- FloridAquatics continues treating and maintaining the aquatic vegetation growth in our canal system
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
- Broadmoor Park (grasses)
- White Marsh (grasses and water lettuce)
- Pine Valley(grasses and water lettuce)
