



Administration

- Collected and processed 64 estoppels and 64 transfers for the month of July
- During the week, 89 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries and applications
- Processed and mailed out 48 new homeowner packets for the month of July

- Processed 5 Notices of Intent to Claim of Lien on properties in the Oakland
 Hills and Pebble Beach sections for unpaid assessments and violation fines
- Processed 147 parking passes and additional permits for the month of July
- This week, we worked with 5 RWA members to help them secure a contract to remove Brazilian Peppers and dead trees on their unimproved vacant lots.
 Initially, 492 unimproved vacant lots were in violation due to Brazilian Pepper Trees or dead trees. So far, we have worked with members to clear 167 of those unimproved vacant lots
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office has been busy notarizing
 documents for our members and is proud to have helped 30 people this
 month. If you need a document notarized, you can visit the RWA office. This
 service is offered for free because it's one of the ways we can assist you better
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional 19 signs this week
- Collected approximately \$5500 this week from members who had past-due payments for violation fines and assessments

The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:

- We have started trimming the landscaping and spot-treating the weeds around the **5** front entrance signs from Cape Haze Drive to East Boulevard
- Replaced all of the American flags at the Memorial Parks and Broadmoor Park
- Removed a large pine tree from the greenbelt in the Long Meadow section
- Removed a large dead pine tree near homes around L11 in Broadmoor Park

- Continuing to mow around the 3 1/2 miles of walking paths inside Broadmoor Park
- Trimmed around the Humpback Bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, and Pinehurst sections and will begin trimming them in the Broadmoor sections next week
- Mowed the vacant lots in the Pinehurst and Broadmoor sections and will continue mowing in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow sections next week
