- We have recently released 3 new construction deposits this week, increasing our total ongoing new construction projects to 231 homes. These homes are currently awaiting final occupancy certification under the New Construction Clean Site Program

- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office is pleased to offer notarization services for our members. So far this month, we've successfully assisted 11 individuals! - Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **22** signs this week
- Collected approximately \$850 this week from members with past-due payments for deed restriction violations

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:
- Removing dead pine trees and fallen branches from common areas and behind adjacent properties in Broadmoor Park near L11 and L05
- Successfully installed a brand new Justrite diesel transfer pump on the 500-gallon tank at Maintenance Building A
- Treated the weeds along the Apex bridges and the shoreline in the Oakland Hills,
 Pebble Beach, Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections
- Hauled away **10** cubic yards of miscellaneous debris along the roads, right of ways, and the common areas in the **Oakland Hills sections**
- Mowing and treating the weeds along the 3 1/2 miles of walking paths at Broadmoor Park
- Weeds were spot-treated in the walkways and landscaped beds at all Memorial Parks and Gazebo Island
- Cleaned up 1 unimproved vacant property under Section 16 in the Pinehurst section. These properties are neglected and are being charged for our services and fined https://rotondawest.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Treated the weeds at 1 property under construction Section 5. in the White
 Marsh section that are neglected (they are being charged for our services and fined) https://rotondawest.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf

- Ensuring that all of the **17** dog stations in Broadmoor Park and Parade Circle are maintained, stocked with bags, and emptied twice a week.
- We are in the process of enhancing the Community Center, Administration Building, and Maintenance Buildings through important painting and repair work.
 We have begun addressing the exterior walls and trim, and we will continue these improvements in the upcoming weeks.
- Mowed the vacant lots in the Oakland Hills section and will continue mowing in the Pebble Beach section next week
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
- Oakland Hills(apex bridge)
- Pinehurst(water lettuce)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections.
