- Processed 4 Notice of Intent to Claim of Lien on properties due to unpaid deed restriction fines and assessments in the White Marsh and Pine Valley sections
- We have recently received approvals for 1 new construction plan approval from
 Cape Cave Corporation and have released 0 new construction deposits this week.
 This brings our total number of ongoing new construction projects to 226 homes.
 These homes are currently awaiting final occupancy certification under the New
 Construction Clean Site Program.
- Mailed out 53 West Ways Newsletters to members who requested them. If you

- Coordinated with our law firm to issue 2 cease and desist letters to members
 whose activities within Broadmoor Park have unfortunately led to damage to our
 native landscapes.
- The Board of Directors has approved a resolution that allows members to choose
 to receive materials for voting electronically. So far, 1750 signed applications for evoting have been received. As a result, members will now receive their election
 packets electronically

- This week, we've made significant progress by updating our Section 16. tree removal list. There are currently 102 members remaining on our list who are working to bring their unimproved vacant lots into compliance by addressing issues related to Brazilian Pepper Trees and dead trees. - The Rotonda West Association Administration Office is pleased to offer notarization services for our members. So far this month, we've successfully assisted 35 individuals! Remember, this valuable service is free of charge, as we are committed to effectively supporting our members

- Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **11** signs this week
- Collected approximately \$700 this week from members with past-due payments for deed restriction violations

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:
- Continued watering the areas where we removed the bike racks and installed grass to ensure that it thrives
- Removed a porta-potty from a vacant lot in the **Pinehurst** section
- Mowing and trimming the Memorial Parks and spot treating the weeds as needed
- Removed trash and various debris from Parade Circle, spanning the Oakland Hills to the Pine Valley sections
- The **flags** were lowered to half-staff this week to honor our fallen law enforcement officers, recognizing their remarkable bravery and steadfast service
- Trimmed the shrubs and spot-sprayed the weeds around the Administration Building and Community Center
- Ensuring that all of the **17** dog stations in **Broadmoor Park** and Parade Circle are maintained, stocked with bags, and emptied twice a week.
- We've continued painting the **Administration Building!** Working on the trim work and will hopefully have the soffits painted next week
- Mowed the vacant lots in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow sections and will continue mowing in the Broadmoor sections next week
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:

- Oakland Hills(tree debris)
- Broadmoor Finger Lakes(tree debris)
- Broadmoor Finger Lakes(Hydrilla)
- Long Meadow(tree debris)
- Memorial Parks(trash debris)
- Contractors
- Asphalt Sealers installed 3 bollards in Broadmoor Park to enhance parking lot safety
- Charlotte County has released 1,000 Triploid Grass Carp into the canal system of Rotonda West.
