- Processed **37** estoppels and **37** transfers so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 24 new homeowner packets so far this month
- Processed **109** parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- The deadline for submitting your annual assessment payment was February 15th. A late payment fee has been applied to all member accounts that have not completed their payments. - We have recently updated the approvals for new construction plans from Cape
 Cave Corporation. This brings our total number of ongoing new construction
 projects to 192 homes. These homes are currently awaiting final occupancy
 certification under the New Construction Clean Site Program.
- During the week, 103 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries, applications, and to make their 2025 Annual Assessment payments. If you need assistance with your payments, please contact Jenny@rotondawest.org
- This week, we've made significant progress by updating our Section 16. tree removal list. There are currently 97 members remaining on our list who are working to bring their unimproved vacant lots into compliance by addressing issues related to Brazilian Pepper Trees and dead trees. - The Rotonda West Association Administration Office is pleased to offer notarization services for our members. So far this month, we've successfully assisted 21 individuals! We encourage you to visit the RWA office if you need a document notarized. Please ensure your documents are in English to help streamline the process. Remember, this valuable service is free of charge, as we are committed to effectively supporting our members

- Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **22** signs this week
- Collected approximately \$950 this week from members with past-due payments for deed restriction violations

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:
- Mowed and trimmed the grass as needed around the Community Center and Administration Buildings
- Trimmed the palmettos and palm trees at the front entrance of Broadmoor Park to improve visibility
- Successfully repaired a bench at Gazebo Island Memorial Park and another bench in Broadmoor Park
- Cleared 120 yards of illegally dumped dirt and debris from unimproved vacant lots in the White Marsh and Broadmoor sections
- Removed several dead pine trees and invasive Brazilian pepper species from Broadmoor Park and will continue this work in the coming weeks
- Collected branches and various debris from the canal system in the Broadmoor and Long Meadow sections
- Ensuring that all of the **17** dog stations in **Broadmoor Park** and Parade Circle are maintained, stocked with bags, and emptied twice a week.
- We have continued painting **the Maintenance Building.** We are working on the trim and have started painting the soffits, which we will continue in the coming weeks
- Mowed the vacant lots in the Pine Valley sections, all of the Greenbelts, and began mowing in the Oakland Hills and Pebble Beach sections
