Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:
- Mowing at the front entrance of Broadmoor Park, along with cleaning 3.5 miles of walking paths, branches, and miscellaneous debris
- Mowed and trimmed the grass around the Administration and Community Center buildings
- Mowing the lush swales, expansive fields, and surroundings of the lakes in Broadmoor Park
- Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds at the corners of the Rebel Court Bridge and the intersections
- Mowing, trimming, and treating the weeds at all Memorial Parks and Gazebo Island

- Removed several dead pine trees and invasive Brazilian pepper species from near L11 and L12 in Broadmoor Park
- Ensuring that all of the **17** dog stations in **Broadmoor Park** and Parade Circle are maintained, stocked with bags, and emptied twice a week.
- Mowed the vacant lots in the White Marsh and Pine Valley sections; will continue mowing in the Pine Valley sections next week
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
- Oakland Hills(grasses)
- Pinehurst(Water lettuce)
- Broadmoor(Water lettuce and grasses)
- Long Meadow(Water lettuce and grasses)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections.

- **Asphalt Sealers** has begun making asphalt repairs in the parking lot of the Community Center and Administration Building in Broadmoor Park. They will start seal coating these areas in the coming weeks.
- The paving contractor, AJAX, has begun preliminary work in the Pine Valley section near Rotonda Blvd South. They are focusing on edging to create a straight line.
 The Contractor indicates that actual paving is expected to start on Monday, July 14th, or around that date, in the Pine Valley section
