- Processed 32 estoppels and 32 transfers so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 16 new homeowner packets so far this month
- Processed **59** parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- The deadline for submitting your annual assessment payment was February 15th. A late payment fee has been applied to all member accounts that have not completed their payments. - The Residential Modification Committee has been diligently working to process and approve 111 applications so far this month <u>To ensure that your application is</u> <u>processed efficiently and approved, please make sure to complete your entire</u> <u>Residential Modification Application</u>
- This week, we've made significant progress by updating our Section 16. tree removal list. There are currently 102 members remaining on our list who are working to bring their unimproved vacant lots into compliance by addressing issues related to Brazilian Pepper Trees and dead trees. - Processed and mailed out 15 delinquency letters for unpaid violations and assessments
- Processed 7 Claims of Lien on properties with deed restrictions and unpaid assessments in the Pinehurst and White Marsh section
- Processed 2 Notice of Intent to Foreclosure Lien on properties due to unpaid deed restriction fines in the Long Meadow section
- A notice has been issued to foreclose on a property located in the Pine Valley section

- We have recently received approvals for 1 new construction plan from Cape Cave
 Corporation and have released 0 new construction deposits this week. This brings
 our total number of ongoing new construction projects to 191 homes. These homes
 are currently awaiting final occupancy certification under the New Construction
 Clean Site Program.
- During the week, 122 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries, applications, and to make their 2025 Annual Assessment payments. If you need assistance with your payments, please contact Jenny@rotondawest.org
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office is pleased to offer notarization services for our members. So far this month, we've successfully assisted 22 individuals! We encourage you to visit the RWA office if you need a document notarized. Please ensure your documents are in English to help streamline the process. Remember, this valuable service is free of charge, as we are committed to effectively supporting our members
- Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **20** signs this week
- Collected approximately \$4520 this week from members with past-due payments for deed restriction violations

Rotonda West Maintenance Staff

- The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:
- Mowing and picking up branches along the 3.5-mile walking paths and lakes in Broadmoor Park
- Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds at all Memorial Parks and Gazebo Island
- Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds around all 5 front entrance signs
- Mowed, trimmed, and treated the weeds along Parade Circle and the side streets from Oakland Hills through Pine Valley sections

- Spot treated invasive species and non-native plants from the canal banks in the **Pinehurst, Broadmoor, and Long Meadow sections**
- Applied spot treatments to the weeds around all segment signs in the White
 Marsh and Pine Valley sections
- Treated the apex bridges for weeds and invasive plants in the Oakland Hills,
 Pebble Beach, Pinehurst, and Broadmoor sections
- All Humpback bridges on Rotonda Circle, from Oakalnd Hills through the Pine Valley sections, have been sprayed
- Mowed, trimmed, and edged the areas around the Community Center and the Administration building
- Cleared and trimmed the overhanging brush along the walkways at Parade Circle in the Oakland Hills section
- Mowed the corner lots on West Blvd, North Blvd and East Blvd along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd
- Mowed the meadows, fields, and swales across the **170** acres of Broadmoor Park
- We treated weeds and invasive species at all intersections and Humpback bridges along Rotonda Circle, Boundary Blvd, Cape Haze Drive, West Blvd, Rebel Ct, North Blvd, and East Blvd
- We are clearing debris from 4 construction sites under Section 5 in the Pebble
 Beach, White Marsh and Pine Valley section. The builders were given ample time
 to clean up, but have failed to do so. As a result, they are being fined and charged

- Cleaned up 2 unimproved vacant properties under Section 16 in the Pinehurst and Pebble Beach section. These properties are neglected and are being charged for our services and fined https://rotondawest.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/09/P-P-1.6.pdf
- Ensuring that all of the **17** dog stations in **Broadmoor Park** and Parade Circle are maintained, stocked with bags, and emptied twice a week.

- Mowed the vacant lots in the Pinehurst, Broadmoor, and Long Meadow sections; will continue mowing in the Long Meadow and White Marsh sections next week
- Invasives, grasses, and submersed plants have been sprayed in the canals and areas listed below:
- Oakland Hills(grasses)
- Pebble Beach(Water lettuce and grasses)
- Broadmoor(algae treatments)
- Broadmoor Park(algae and grasses)
- Long Meadow(algae treatments)
- White Marsh(algae treatments)
- The Truxor has been cutting and removing Vallisneria and grasses in the following sections.
- White Marsh(Water lettuce and Vallisneria)
- White Marsh(Water Hyacinth)
- Pine Valley(Vallisneria)
- Contractors
- Asphalt Sealers has completed repairs to the asphalt in the parking lot of the Community Center and Administration Building in Broadmoor Park. They sealcoated these areas and added extra safety arrows and speed bumps.
- The paving contractor, AJAX, has begun preliminary work in the Pine Valley section near Rotonda Blvd South. They are focusing on edging to create a straight line.
 The Contractor has started paving in the Pine Valley section on Rotonda Blvd South
