- Processed **19** estoppels and **19** transfers so far this month
- Processed and mailed out 14 new homeowner packets so far this month.
- Processed 72 parking passes and additional permits so far this month
- The deadline for submitting your annual assessment payment was February 15th. A late payment fee has been applied to all member accounts that have not completed their payments. - This week, we've made significant progress by updating our Section 16. tree
  removal list. There are currently 97 members remaining on our list who are working
  to bring their unimproved vacant lots into compliance by addressing issues related
  to Brazilian Pepper Trees and dead trees. If you're interested in finding out whether

- Processed and mailed out 10 delinquency letters for unpaid violations and assessments
- The Board of Directors has approved a resolution that allows members to choose
  to receive materials for voting electronically. So far, 2026 signed applications for evoting have been received. As a result, members will now receive their election
  packets electronically
- We have recently received approvals for 12 new construction plan approval from Cape Cave Corporation and have released 1 new construction deposits this week. This brings our total number of ongoing new construction projects to 204 homes.
   These homes are currently awaiting final occupancy certification under the New Construction Clean Site Program.
- Assisted members in setting up payment plans and have successfully added 1 additional member this week
- Processed 3 Notice of Intent to Lien on properties in the Oakland Hills and Pine
   Valley sections for past due violation notices
- Released 3 Claim of Liens on properties with deed restrictions and unpaid assessments in the Pebble Beach and Long Meadow sections
- During the week, 79 members visited the Rotonda West Association Office for inquiries, applications, and to make their 2025 Annual Assessment payments. If you need assistance with your payments, please contact Jenny@rotondawest.org
- The Rotonda West Association Administration Office is pleased to offer notarization services for our members. So far this month, we've successfully assisted 37 individuals! - Continuing to pull unapproved signs or posts in the common areas, right of ways, and vacant lots, removing an additional **14** signs this week

 Collected approximately \$6,556 this week from members with past-due payments for deed restriction violations and past due assessments

## **Rotonda West Maintenance Staff**

- The Maintenance Staff has completed or is completing the following tasks:
- Mowing and picking up branches along the 3.5-mile walking paths, lakes, and the front entrance in Broadmoor Park
- Spot-treated We spot-treated weeds as needed at all Humpback and Apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach, and Pinehurst sections
- At the Gazebo Island in the Oakland Hills section, we have added riprap around the
  island to help prevent shoreline erosion. We removed the diseased and damaged
  trees, as well as broken concrete. We are currently grading and adding soil as
  needed, and in the coming weeks, we will be installing brick pavers and sod
- Mowed the corner lots along Rotonda Circle and Boundary Blvd from Cape Haze
   Drive through East Blvd
- 10 hours of maintenance were performed this week, including the replacement of a power steering pump and a new pump hose in the 5115M tractor, as well as a spindle on the 72-inch zero-turn mower.
- Mowed around and spot-treated the weeds around the 5 front entrance signs located from Cape Haze Drive to Boulevard East
- Mowed around all of the Apex bridges in the Oakland Hills, Pebble Beach,
   Broadmoor, and White Marsh sections
- Mowed, trimmed, and edged the areas around the Community Center and the Administration building
- Removed invasive plant species along the canal banks in the Oakland Hills and the Pinehurst sections

- Cleaned up 1 unimproved vacant property under Section 16 in the Oakland
  Hills sections. These properties are neglected and are being charged for our

- Long Meadow(grasses)
- White Marsh(grasses)
- Pine Valley(grasses and water lettuce)
