

How to Add CondoVoter's Email Address to Your Email Safe List

AOL

If you are unsure how to adjust your AOL SPAM filter to allow for emails from senders you know, AOL advises that you should:

Add sender to safe list

1. Go to **Options - Mail Settings - Spam Settings**.
2. Find the "Sender Filter" section and click to "Allow mail from addresses I specify".
3. Enter the email address and click **Save Settings**.

In CondoVoter's case that would be noreply@condovoter.com in the email address.

Comcast

If you are unsure how to adjust your Comcast SPAM filter to allow for emails from senders you know, Comcast says you should add the sender to your Xfinity Address Book. To do that:

1. Sign in to your Xfinity Email account.
2. Click the **Address Book** tab at the top of the page.
3. In the left-hand column, select **Address Book** from the "My address books" drop-down menu.
4. Click **New contact**.
5. Fill in the contact's details, such as their name and email address, in the "New contact" fields.
6. Click **Save** to add the contact.

In CondoVoter's case that would be CondoVoter for the name and noreply@condovoter.com in the email address.

Gmail

If you are unsure how to adjust your Gmail SPAM filter to allow for emails from senders you know, Gmail says:

Add the sender to your Contacts

1. Go to Google Contacts or click the grid icon (waffle) in the top-right corner of your Gmail page and select "Contacts".
2. Click "Create contact" in the top left.
3. Fill in the contact's information, such as their name, email, and phone number.
4. Click "Save".

In CondoVoter's case that would be CondoVoter for the name and noreply@condovoter.com in the email address.

iCloud

If you are unsure how to adjust your iCloud filter to allow for emails from senders you know, iCloud advises that you should add the sender to your contacts list. To add a contact in iCloud:

1. Go to icloud.com/contacts and sign in.
2. Click the **Add** button (it may look like a plus sign).
3. Select **Create New Contact**.
4. Enter the person's name and email address, then click **Done** or save the contact.

In CondoVoter's case you would add CondoVoter to the name field and noreply@condovoter.com to the email field

MSN

If you are unsure how to adjust your MSN SPAM filter to allow for emails from senders you know, MSN says:

"Manage your Safe and Blocked Senders lists

- Navigate to **Settings** (gear icon) – **Mail - Junk Email**.
- Add any trusted email addresses or domains to the **Safe senders and domains** list.
- To fix mistakes, go to your **Blocked senders list** and remove any addresses you don't want to block."

In CondoVoter's case that would be CondoVoter for the name and noreply@condovoter.com in the email address.

Outlook

If you are unsure on how to adjust your OUTLOOK SPAM filter to allow for emails from senders you know, OUTLOOK advises that you should add the sender to your Safe Senders List.

To add a contact to your Safe Senders list in Outlook, you can go to the Junk Email settings and manually add the email address to the "Safe senders and domains" list. In CondoVoter's case you would add noreply@condovoter.com to the "Safe senders and domains" list.

SBCGlobal

If you are unsure how to adjust your SBCGlobal SPAM filter to allow emails from senders you know, SBCGlobal advises that you should add the sender to your contacts list. To add a contact in SBCGlobal:

1. Open your SBCGlobal address book.
2. Click "Add Contact".
3. Fill in the sender's email address.
4. Click "Save Contact".

In CondoVoter's case you would add noreply@condovoter.com to the email field

Verizon

We have investigated this issue and found that you cannot stop emails from going to junk in Verizon.net because **Verizon has retired its email service** and Verizon has moved existing accounts to AOL and Yahoo.

To edit your SPAM filters, you will need to determine your new email provider's methodology to find out how to whitelist senders and prevent their messages from being marked as spam. Once you do that, you will probably be advised to create a contact for CondoVoter. To do that you would add CondoVoter in the name field and add noreply@condovoter.com to the email field.

Yahoo

If you are unsure how to adjust your Yahoo SPAM filter to allow emails from senders you know, Yahoo advises that you should add the sender to your contacts list. To add a sender to your contacts in Yahoo:

1. Open your Yahoo Mail on a computer.

2. Click the Contacts icon, which looks like a person icon.
3. Click Add a new contact or New Contact.
4. Enter the sender's name and email address.
5. Click Save.

In CondoVoter's case that would be CondoVoter for the name and noreply@condovoter.com in the email address.
